Chapter 2

BLOODY MARY

Definition: a cocktail consisting essentially of vodka and usually spiced tomato juice.

The Drink is named after Queen Mary Tudor and her bloody reign against Protestants in England in the 1500s. Theorists claim that tomato juice represents the blood shed during this time and the fiery vodka illustrates Queen Mary Tudor's wicked means of executing her enemies.

Harry's Bar in Paris recently celebrated the 100th birthday of the Bloody Mary, the vodka - tomato juice cocktail believed to have been invented at the iconic watering hole in 1921.

"Many moons ago, we drank an extraordinarily good Bloody Mary in a bar in Bristol, and discovered the barman's secret was the terminally unfashionable local tippie, Bristol cream sherry, instead of vodka. It adds a subtle sweetness and richness to the drink and, as it turns out, it's not actually that original: Lindsey Bareham rinses the glass with sherry in her Big Red Book of Tomatoes, while Victoria Moore specifies bone-dry Fino sherry or the slightly fuller Amontillado sherry, saying that for her: "It's the sherry that really makes [the drink], bridging the gulf between the hot but clean spirit and the fruity tomatoes." So, your choice, vodka or sherry or vodka and sherry?"

Graham's Quinta dos Malvedos 2006 (Half Bottle) – 1/2 £35.00

A lovely complex nose with excellent sweet and rich fruit aromas, packed with solid, structured, rich and intense black fruit flavours and an admirably long finish.

Smith Woodhouse Quinta da Madalena 2005 – 1/2 £69.00

Comfortably into its long plateau of maturity, with its deep colour just beginning to fade at the rim, this rich, ripe Single-Quinta Vintage Port offers typical aromas of violets and roses supported by rich, ripe fruit, and complex, mellow finish.

Quarles Harris 1977 – 1/2 £120.00

A vintage initially destined to be legendary, these have great weight, backbone and power, some Quintas wines have not been as consistent as first thought but Quarles Harris which is a smaller Quinta has produced a fine effort with a nice intensity of fruit, elegant and balanced with a silky smooth finish.

A rare pudding wine from Corsica which is a sweet red wine from the fragrant Muscateddu grape (related to the red Sciacarello of Corsica), this ruby-coloured, unoaked and unfortified wine brims with aromas of strawberry jam and allspice. The palate is fresh and equally aromatic; resinous, woody flavours mix with cherries and bittersweet orange peel. Perfect with a chocolate pudding.
