Chapter 2

BLOODY MARY

Definition: a cocktail consisting essentially of vodka and usually spiced tomato juice.

The Drink is named after Queen Mary Tudor and her bloody reign against Protestants in England in the 1500s. Theorists claim that tomato juice represents the blood shed during this time and the fiery vodka illustrates Queen Mary Tudor's wicked means of executing her enemies.

Harry's Bar in Paris recently celebrated the 100th birthday of the Bloody Mary, the vodka - tomato juice cocktail believed to have been invented at the iconic watering hole in 1921.

"Many moons ago, we drank an extraordinarily good Bloody Mary in a bar in Bristol, and discovered the barman's secret was the terminally unfashionable local tippie, Bristol cream sherry, instead of vodka. It adds a subtle sweetness and richness to the drink and, as it turns out, it's not actually that original."

Lindsey Bareham rinses the glass with sherry in her Big Red Book of Tomatoes, while Victoria Moore specifies bone-dry Fino sherry or the slightly fuller Montillado sherry, saying that for her: "It's the sherry that really makes [the drink], bridging the gulf between the hot but clean spirit and the fruity tomatoes." So, your choice, vodka or sherry or vodka and sherry?"

Noun: ready to be drawn from a barrel or keg; not bottled or canned.

Noun: cask-conditioned beer that is served traditionally, without additional gas pressure.

Roebuck I.B.A – 4.8% ABV £4.60 A PINT

Vibrant tropical fruit aromas begin the fun and the punchline comes from the refreshing citrus finish. Everything you expect and more from an Individual Buck Ale or even an Indian Pale Ale.

LAGER BEERS OF THE SEASON

Noun: A kind of effervescent beer which is light in colour and body.

Peroni Nastro Azzuro – Italy, 5.1% ABV £5.80 A PINT

Francesco Peroni established his first brewery in Vigevano in Pavia province. It was called Birra Peroni and still bears the founder's name to this day. Peroni Nastro Azzurro exemplifies the traditions of Italian craftsmanship, passion and flair upon which it was formed.

Hofmeister – Germany, 5% ABV £5.55 A PINT

Many years ago the once famous 'follow the bear' beer disappeared from our shores, but now it is back stronger and far more authentic to its Bavarian roots. It is a slow brewed Helles Pale Lager with a refreshing taste. We are the first stockists in the North of England!

Roebuck Craft Lager - £5.40 A PINT

PORT

Noun: a sweet fortified dessert wine from Portugal.

Graham's Fine White Port – 1 £3.75 1 £13.75 1 £27.50

Made from only white grape varieties, this Port has a gorgeous pale, golden colour with fresh, delicate flavour. Equally delicious served as an aperitif over ice or mixed with elderflower tonic for a refreshing long drink.

Graham's Six Grapes Reserve – 1 £4.50 1 £16.25 1 £32.50

With a youthful, fruity style, Six Grapes is a perfect wine to accompany dark chocolate or blue cheese, or simply to relax with at the end of the day.

Dow's Late Bottled Vintage – 1 £5.50 1 £17.00 1 £33.50

A wine of a single year but it is not a "declared" Vintage Port. Late Bottled Vintage Port is aged in seasoned oak casks and bottled when it is between four and six years old. Full bodied, with flavours of dark prunes and a very long spicy slightly dry finish.

Graham's 10 year-old Tawny – 1 £8.00 1 £29.50 1 £58.00

Skill, craftsmanship and dedication in the form of three unique arts – the art of blending, the art of cooperage and the art of ageing to produce extraordinary Tawny Port. Rich mature fruit flavours, beautifully mellowed with a luscious long finished.

Graham's 20 year-old Tawny – 1 £12.00 1 £40.00 1 £80.00

After two decades of care, this wine is a wonderful expression of Tawny Port. For those who appreciate quality in every detail. A matured, concentrated palate with full honeyed fruit. Gorgeously mellow, with an amazing, long finish.

Graham's Quinta dos Malvedos 2006 (Half Bottle) – 1 £35.00

A lovely complex nose with excellent sweet and rich fruit aromas, packed with solid, structured, rich and intense black fruit flavours and an admirably long finish.

Smith Woodhouse Quinta da Madalena 2005 – 1 £69.00

Comfortably into its long plateau of maturity, with its deep colour just beginning to fade at the rim, this rich, ripe Single-Quinta Vintage Port offers typical aromas of violets and roses supported by rich, ripe fruit, and complex, mellow finish.

Quarles Harris 1977 – 1 £120.00

A vintage initially destined to be legendary, these have great weight, backbone and power, some Quintas wines have not been as consistent as first thought but Quarles Harris which is a smaller Quinta has produced a fine effort with a nice intensity of fruit, elegant and balanced with a silky smooth finish.

Chapter 9

PUDDING WINE

Noun: sweeter wines that offer a distinctive 'liquid pudding' alternative after your meal or indeed a wonderful accompaniment to your dessert or cheese board.

Fernando de Castilla Classic Pedro Ximénez NV – 50ML £3.95 100ML £6.95

Opaquely dark mahogany colour. The nose seduces with intense dried fruit aromas of raisins, prunes and dates.

Ginestet Classique Sauternes – 50ML £3.00 100ML £5.95

Rich in honey and sweet floral tones with hints of citrus marmalade. The palate smooth with similar sweet floral and honeyed apricot flavours.

Domaine de Grange Neuve Monbazillac – 50ML £3.00 100ML £5.95

A fabulous dessert wine, sweet and luscious with a great backbone of fine acidity for a clean finish.

Domaine Fiumicicoli Muscateddu, Vin de Corse – 50ML £3.95 100ML £6.95

A rare pudding wine from Corsica which is a sweet red wine from the fragrant Muscateddu grape (related to the red Sciacarello of Corsica), this ruby-coloured, unoaked and unfortified wine brims with aromas of strawberry jam and allspice. The palate is fresh and equally aromatic; resinous, woody flavours mix with cherries and bittersweet orange peel. Perfect with a chocolate pudding.
